Biographie Denise Fagiani

Italian flautist, she began studying the flute at the age of 8 and then in 2014 she graduated from the Conservatorio "G.Verdi" in Milan under the guidance of Prof. Silvia Vergamini.

In 2021 she began his Master's degree at the Anton Bruckner Privatuniversität in Linz in the class of Prof. Johanna Dömötör. During her studies she participated as an actual student in flute masterclasses with Paolo Taballione, Sebastian Jacot, Andrea Manco, Silvia Careddu, Emily Beynon, Andrea Lieberknecht, Andrea Oliva and Mario Caroli...

From 2018 to 2023 she played as second flute and piccolo with the Youth Orchestra "Luigi Cherubini", conducted by Maestro Riccardo Muti.

From 2020 to 2022 she was a member of the orchestra of the Academy of Teatro alla Scala as flute and piccolo.

In 2021 she won the audition as first flute at the Philharmonie Salzburg.

Since 2022, she has been collaborating with some of Italy's greatest orchestras, such as the Orchestra del Teatro alla Scala, the Orchestra del Teatro la Fenice in Venice, the Orchestra del Teatro Regio in Turin, the Orchestra dell'Arena di Verona, the Orchestra Haydn in Bolzano, the Orchestra del Teatro Petruzzelli in Bari, the Symphony Orchestra in Milan, La Toscanini in Parma and the Orchestra dei Pomeriggi musicali as flute and piccolo performing operatic and symphonic repertoires.

She has performed under such renowned conductors as Riccardo Muti, Valerij Gergiev, Lorenzo Viotti, Donato Renzetti, Kristjan Jarvi, Leonidas Kavakos (conductor and soloist), Christoph Eschenbach, Claus Peter Flor, David Coleman, Hartmut Haenchen and Vasily Petrenko.

She participated in numerous festivals such as the Ravenna Festival, Italian Opera Academy in Ravenna, the Ljubljana Festival, the Ravello Festival and she played for the EXPO 2020 celebration in Dubai.
